PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

- At the Annual Meeting of the Parish Council held on 8th April 2022, Don Wiltshire has been unanimously voted in as Chair of Covenham Parish Council for the financial year 2022-2023.
- The Parish Council is also pleased to have co-opted four new parish councillors. We welcome Nicky Gulley Brown who has rejoined after a few years' break but very much involved with the Jubilee Committee; Gillian Pollard who has moved to Covenham St Mary in November 2020. Both Nicky and Gillian were co-opted in the April meeting.

Angela Quinton and Ian Appleby are long-time residents of Covenham St Bartholomew. Both were co-opted in the Annual Meeting on 11th May.

- On a sad note, the Parish Council had two recent resignations. Emma Cooling who was Vice-Chair has moved away from the parish early in the year. Gareth Smith who was Chair during the previous year had also unfortunately resigned. We would like to thank both Gareth and Emma for their services to the Parish Council.
- The Give Way markings on Cold Harbour Lane/Newbridge Lane has finally been completed. Lincolnshire County Council (LCC) also agreed to put a Give Way sign near to the Anglian Water sub-station.
- LCC has also agreed to erect Beware of Horses signs on Ings Lane and on the Main Road close to Grange Lane.
- An Archer Survey is scheduled this month to gauge speed and traffic on the Main Road in Covenham St Bartholomew.
- The next meeting of the Parish Council will be held on Thursday, 4th August 2022, 7pm at the Parish Rooms. Residents are welcome to attend and feedback any issues they have concerns about.
- A road sweeper from ELDC had been requested to clean up along Ings Lane and the Main Road in St Barts.
- The Parish Council would like to thank residents who have tidied their trees which were a hazard and helped improve visibility.

Dog Fouling

It has become increasingly apparent that dog fouling is definitely happening down the side of Ings Lane, also the top footpath to the south of the village adjacent to the cow field in-between Yarburgh Road & Louth Road.

Please make use of the free dog bags courtesy of residents who care about the village.

Do not be one of those who need to be named and shamed.

The Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime & Policing Act 2014 provides District Councils with the powers to deal with people who fail to clean up their dog mess.

The Fixed Penalty for dog fouling is currently set at £100.00. If you are issued with a Fixed Penalty Notice you must pay the amount due within 14 days. If you fail to pay the amount due, the matter will be referred to the ELDC solicitor.

If you can help us to identify anyone who lets their dog foul in public areas, then please contact ELDC using the <u>Report Dog Fouling Incident Form</u>. Please be advised that those who report incidents may be required to submit a formal witness statement which can be used to support any further action.

ELDC Environmental Crime Officers regularly patrol the District and will take action to deal with dog fouling hotspots.
